***IF YOU TAKE GLP-1 AGONIST FOR DIABETES OR WEIGHT LOSS, IT NEEDS TO BE HELD FOR 7 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS PLEAS CALL 302-677-1617. ***

It is VERY important that your colon is cleared of all stool before your colonoscopy. This will allow your doctor to see the lining of your colon and look for any abnormalities; such as polyps or growths.

• Take the prescribed **bowel prep** medication that you will get from your pharmacy as directed on the following page.

Special Diet to follow day prior to procedure:

You are only allowed to have **CLEAR LIQUIDS THE WHOLE DAY BEFORE** your colonoscopy.

Examples/Suggestions:

-Lemon-lime or Ginger ale sodas

- white grape juice

Jell-O or popsicles (NOT red or purple)

-coffee or tea (NO creamer or milk)

-Apple juice

- hroth

What you need to bring the day of the procedure:

- An adult drive
- Photo Identification
- Health Insurance card
- 3 pages of paperwork filled out (Health Questionnaire attached to this page)

A nurse from the endoscopy unit will call you a few days before your procedure to review your instructions and help you with any questions you may have about your procedure.

There is to be nothing in your mouth 3 hours before your arrival, no gum, or candy, not even water. Failure to comply may result in cancellation.

There is a **CANCELATION FEE** of \$75.00 if less than 48-hour notice is given.
